READY, SET, GO! We have a departure date for Alaska! This helps significantly after sitting a while waiting through the pregnancy and Holidays of 2017. We will be departing on April 9<sup>th</sup> from Nebraska on our last visitation trip, but will be hauling everything with us so as to head north and arrive in Glennallen at the latest by the first full week in May 2018, Lord willing.

In the meantime, we are planning other visitations and support discovery. Our first trip is starting January 15<sup>th</sup> and will take us through Colorado, Wyoming, South Dakota, and Minnesota. The other solid set date for our Home Service is a Missions Conference April 6-8<sup>th</sup> at Crossroads Bible Church in Nebraska. In late February and March we are hoping to get in another trip or two for visits as well.

### Transitions – An Invitation to Join in the Journey!

When we began this change in ministry we had to place before our God the many options we had in front of us. Three of them surfaced to the top – an Alaska ministry, an Indiana ministry, and an option to leave ministry and take a Texas Job. Having these options to explore gave us an ability to examine (through Godly mentors, friends, and prayer) and understand God's specific calling for us to continue in ministry. Once we understood what God's call is for our family, everything else fell into place. We believe that He will put everything regarding our needs to fulfill this calling into place as well (Matthew 6:33-34; Philippians 4:19).

With SEND and then WIM, there was a structure in place that had a formula for what they believed we should raise in financial support. This is what we are accustomed to, but this...

...time, we have been given that responsibility – So...we have used our experience and consulted others in coming up with what we have put before The Lord as our Monthly need, \$6500, and asked Him to supply whatever portion of that amount that He wants us to return to Alaska with by the date we leave for the field. That date has now been set and we look forward to what God will supply!

## Ministry Needs

1. Additional Monthly Support of \$2275 a month mainly to cover renting an abode (~\$1400/mo.) and adding health coverage. It also includes a small cost of living in Alaska increase. We are currently at 65% of the \$6500 need.
2. One-time Expenses (~\$6,000): for travel to Alaska and setup of the house when we arrive.
  - Travel: Minor repair of Vehicles so we are ready to drive the ALCAN (Alaska Canadian Highway) and for Alaska winters. We also need passports now to travel through Canada.
  - Setup costs: Alaska worthy cold weather gear for the whole family, winters in Glennallen can get down to -50 degrees, and replacing some furniture and appliances.
