Ministry Needs

1. Additional Monthly Support of \$2227 a month; mainly to cover renting an abode (~\$1400/mo.) and adding health coverage. It also includes a small cost of living in Alaska increase. We are currently at 66% of the \$6500 need.
2. One-time Expenses (~\$3,000 still needed): for travel to Alaska and setup of the house when we arrive.
 - Travel: Minor repair of our vehicle so we are ready to drive the ALCAN (Alaska Canadian Highway) and for Alaska winters. (We have our passports now to travel through Canada).
 - Setup costs: Alaska worthy cold weather gear for the whole family, winters in Glennallen can get down to -50 degrees, and replacing some furniture and appliances.
